

Egypt Solar Power Plant



Overview

The Abydos Solar PV power plant will generate 1,500GWh of clean energy, powering approximately 300,000 households and will offset 782,300 tons of CO₂ emissions. The project, completed in just 18 months, is one of the largest solar PV plants in Africa. AMEA Power signed the Power Purchase Agreement. Benban Solar Park is a large-scale photovoltaic power station in Egypt with a current installed capacity of 1800 MW (1. The project is being developed by Abydos for Renewable Energy SAE, a special-purpose vehicle wholly owned by Amea Power. Amea Power began construction before financing was completed.
