Overview

Senegal is taking early steps toward electric vehicle (EV) adoption, focusing heavily on public transit rather than private cars. The country has introduced 155 electric buses and plans an all-electric Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) system in Dakar, aiming to cut greenhouse gas. In a significant stride towards reducing its carbon footprint, Senegal is taking decisive steps to transition to electric mobility, thanks to the collaborative efforts of Manufacturing Africa (MA) and the Government of Senegal. In a significant move towards sustainable transportation, Senegal has announced plans to implement a comprehensive regulatory framework to promote and regulate the use of electric vehicles (EVs). Key updates include: Battery Safety Standards: New rules focus on battery safety and hazardous material. Senegal's Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC), or strategy to meet the objectives outlined in the Paris Agreement, calls for a 5% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions across all sectors. Priorities include lowering generation costs by decreasing reliance on imported liquid fuels and expanding.
