

Nigeria's first grid-side energy storage in Lagos



Overview

The hub is powered by a 350 kWp solar PV system integrated with 600 kWh of battery energy storage, engineered and executed by Grid Crux and operated by IHS Towers in partnership with the Kwara State Government. At the United Nations House in Abuja, EM-ONE Energy Solutions deployed a modular solar microgrid featuring 400 kWp of PV and 650 kWh of lithium battery storage.
