## Overview

Italy's largest second-life battery energy storage system was officially launched at Rome-Fiumicino airport yesterday. State-owned gas and electric company Enel's 2.5 MW/10 MWh Pioneer project comprises 762 battery packs and modules. This article explores how this 200MW/800MWh facility redefines grid stability while supporting Italy's 2030 carbon neutrality goals. Developed by Italian utility Enel and airport operator Aeroporti di Roma (ADR), the 10 MWh battery energy storage system (BESS) strengthens the grid. From residential apartments to small commercial spaces, daily electricity usage is no longer limited to basic needs—air conditioning, appliances, and business operations all contribute to it.
