Overview

US utility Consumers Energy has started operations at its 250MW Muskegon solar PV project, its largest in the US state of Michigan. Construction began in June 2024, with engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) firm Burns & McDonnell leading the installation. From tandem module records and high-output PV products to construction starts, manufacturing plans, regulatory actions, and market sourcing shifts, recent developments highlight how project execution, technology deployment, supply-chain expansion, and policy oversight continue to influence global. This marks another major milestone in the company's strategy to decarbonize its iron-ore operations. The project will include around 14,000 solar modules across 7.2 GWh of electricity each year.
