

Solar power station power generation in Albania



Overview

On May 6, 2025, the Albanian government approved the development of two new solar power plants, totaling 54 megawatts (MW) in capacity. Albania relies mostly on hydroelectric resources, therefore, it has difficulties and shortages when water levels are low. The climate in Albania is Mediterranean, so it possesses considerable. Photovoltaic energy is attracting capital at an accelerated pace in Albania, emerging as a new investment pillar for both traditional energy players and diversified business groups. With licenses granted for nearly 980 MW of solar capacity and hundreds of megawatts already operational, the market. In the first eight months of this year, Albania added two solar power plants of an overall 150 MW and a hydropower facility of 48.
